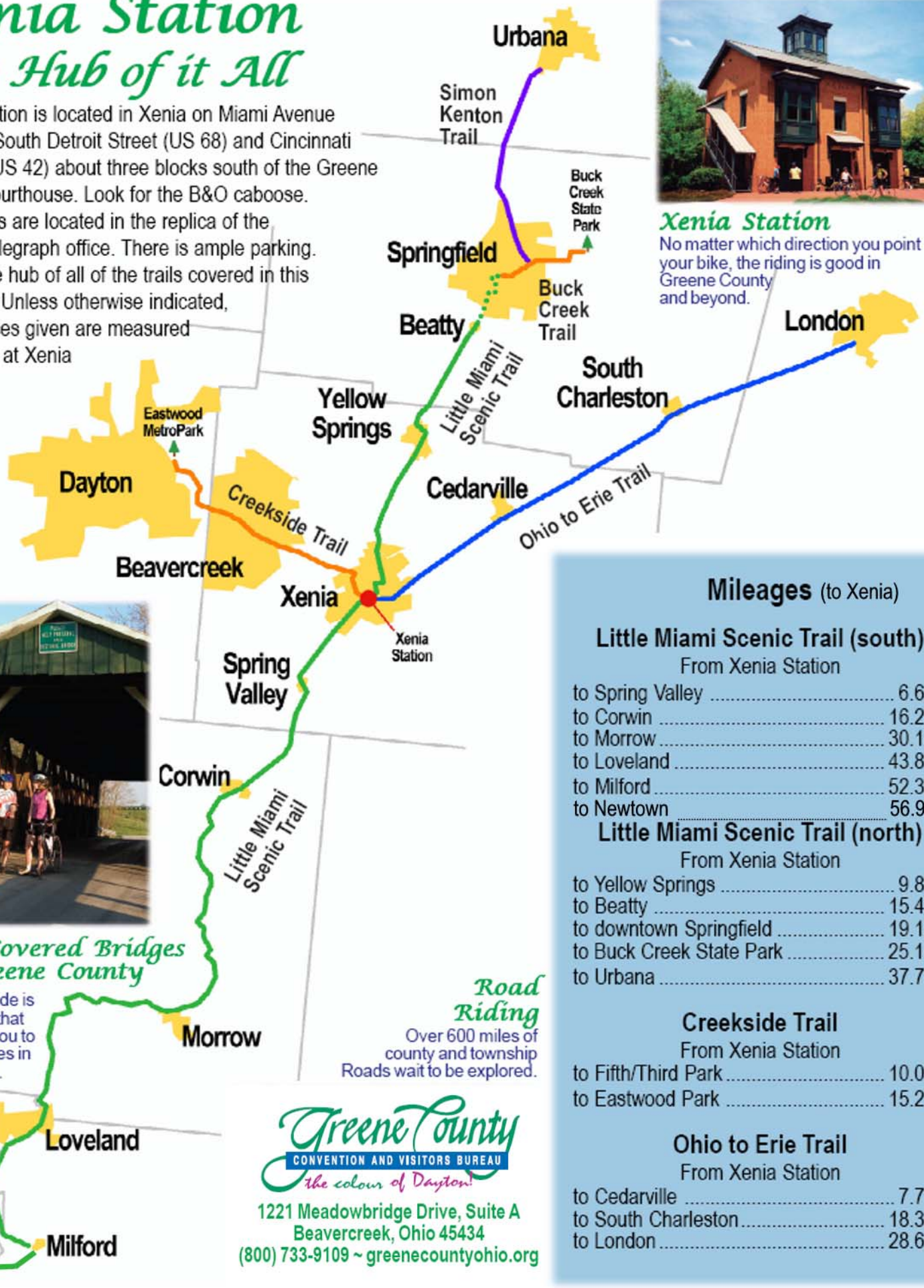
The Hub of it All

Xenia Station is located in Xenia on Miami Avenue between South Detroit Street (US 68) and Cincinnati Avenue (US 42) about three blocks south of the Greene County courthouse. Look for the B&O caboose. Restrooms are located in the replica of the original telegraph office. There is ample parking. This is the hub of all of the trails covered in this brochure. Unless otherwise indicated, all distances given are measured beginning at Xenia Station.
